

Data Protection (UK GDPR) Policy

Our principles

- We retain personal data only as long as necessary, then securely dispose of it.
- We respect individuals' rights, including access, correction and erasure of their data.

Sharing and security

Personal data is shared only with those who need it to deliver our services or to meet a legal obligation, and is protected against unauthorised access, loss or disclosure.

Data breaches

Any suspected personal data breach must be reported immediately to the Managing Director. Reportable breaches will be notified to the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) within 72 hours where required. Our website privacy notice explains how we handle data collected online.
